Dear Southport Family,

Happy New Year! As we step into 2025, I can't help but feel a buzz of excitement for what lies ahead for our church family. The start of a new year is a chance to recalibrate our hearts, deepen our faith, and align our steps with God's direction. Much like the Magi who followed the star to Jesus, we're invited to seek the Light that guides us closer to God.

That theme—seeking the Light—is woven beautifully throughout January's worship services. As we begin with Epiphany Sunday on January 5th, we'll reflect on the Magi's journey and receive our very own Star Gifts: a single word to inspire and guide us throughout the year. Imagine how transformative it could be to focus on one word, letting it draw us deeper into God's presence.

From there, we'll flow into Baptism of the Lord Sunday on January 12th, where we'll reconnect with the waters that mark us as God's beloved. Just as Jesus' baptism affirmed His identity, we'll be reminded of our own belonging in Christ—a truth that anchors and propels us into the world with purpose.

The second half of the month introduces our new sermon series: Walking the Path of Justice: Living Out Micah 6:8. We'll explore God's call to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly. Through scriptures like Isaiah 1:16-17 and Zechariah 7:9-10, we'll wrestle with what it means to live out our faith in practical, impactful ways—acting with compassion, building relationships marked by mercy, and living humbly under God's vision for justice.

If you're feeling inspired to take these themes into your week, here's a quick illustration: Imagine standing at the start of a path with three signposts ahead—Justice, Kindness, and Humility. Which one are you drawn to first? Which feels the most challenging? God doesn't ask us to sprint to the finish but to walk faithfully, step by step, trusting Him to guide us.

I encourage you to make worship a priority this month. Join us for Epiphany Sunday to start the year under the light of the star, reconnect with your baptism on January 12th, and dive into our justice-focused series starting January 19th. Each service will be a chance to grow, connect, and set our hearts on the incredible journey God has for us in 2025.

Let's start this year with open hearts and eager spirits, ready to follow wherever God's Light leads.




Caring After Christmas

If you want to help but can't make it on the day of the event a financial contribution to the Pastor's Ministry fund will help fuel this project.


